<p><i>CACFP regulations require providers to offer at least one type of infant formula. If the infants parents choose to bring a different type of formula they must indicate their desire to do so by filling out the Parent Documentation of Supplying Infant Formula form. The infant formula provided by the parents must be iron – fortified, unless a special diet statement is on file.</i></p> <p><i>Meals consisting only of parent-supplied infant formula are eligible for reimbursement as long as the provider serves the meal.</i></p> <p><i>Formula must be prepared according to manufacturers directions.</i></p>		

*Even though these specialized infant formulas are iron-fortified, a special diet statement is needed to document the need for these formulas. These formulas should not be used unless the infant has a medical need for them. The state of Minnesota requires diet statements to be signed by an MD/CNP/PA/RD/Licensed Nutritionist or DC.
